All County correspondence is sent to your club secretary so please inform us if they are on holiday or you appoint a new officer.



Fines must be paid on time or further fines will be imposed automatically.

Promote the Respect Programme and Club Codes of Conducts – good discipline means less fines and less administration to deal with.

Adult clubs must send the County FA a list of registered players by 30th October each year.



Club accounts should be kept up to date and copies may be requested by the County FA.

Check League rules and requirements to avoid unnecessary fines.



Check league deadlines for player registrations – playing ineligible players can result in fines or awarding of points to the opposition.



All tournaments and charity events need to be affiliated with the County FA Remember to send in a financial statement within 14 days.



International Clearance is needed for players from abroad including Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales.



For most leagues the maximum referee's fees for Surrey is set at £30 per game.



Contact match officials in a timely matter.



Approval is required if playing teams from outside England whether home or away.



Remember to phone in the result of your match to comply with competition rules.



Deal with County and League correspondence in a timely manner to avoid late fines.
